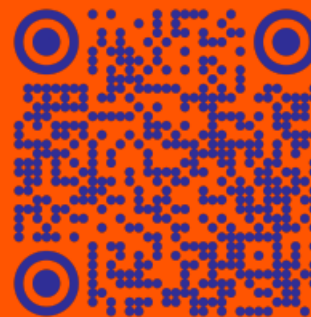

Data Flows

How to model data exchange
across different research
information systems

RIS Synergy establishes the data exchange between the IT systems of funding organisations and research institutions. The key to this is process optimisation via technical interfaces and well-defined data flows. Aiming to improve data quality and freeing up resources for researchers, funding bodies and university administrations by implementing the once-only-principle, RIS Synergy contributes to the sustainable digitisation of the Austrian higher education sector. RIS Synergy is providing standards for exchanging meta data on research information, such as projects, funding programme calls, or publications, which are compliant to international standards (CERIF). The standardised exchange of metadata relieves the administrative workload of researchers, enhances the support. This poster illustrates in detail the data flows of RIS Synergy's use cases throughout the entire
