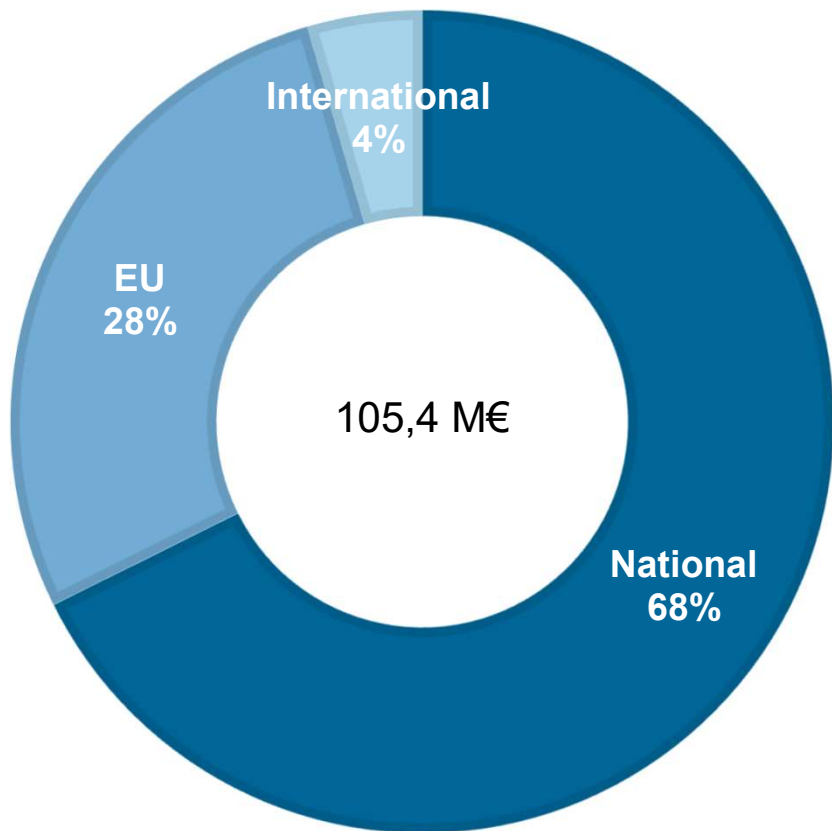

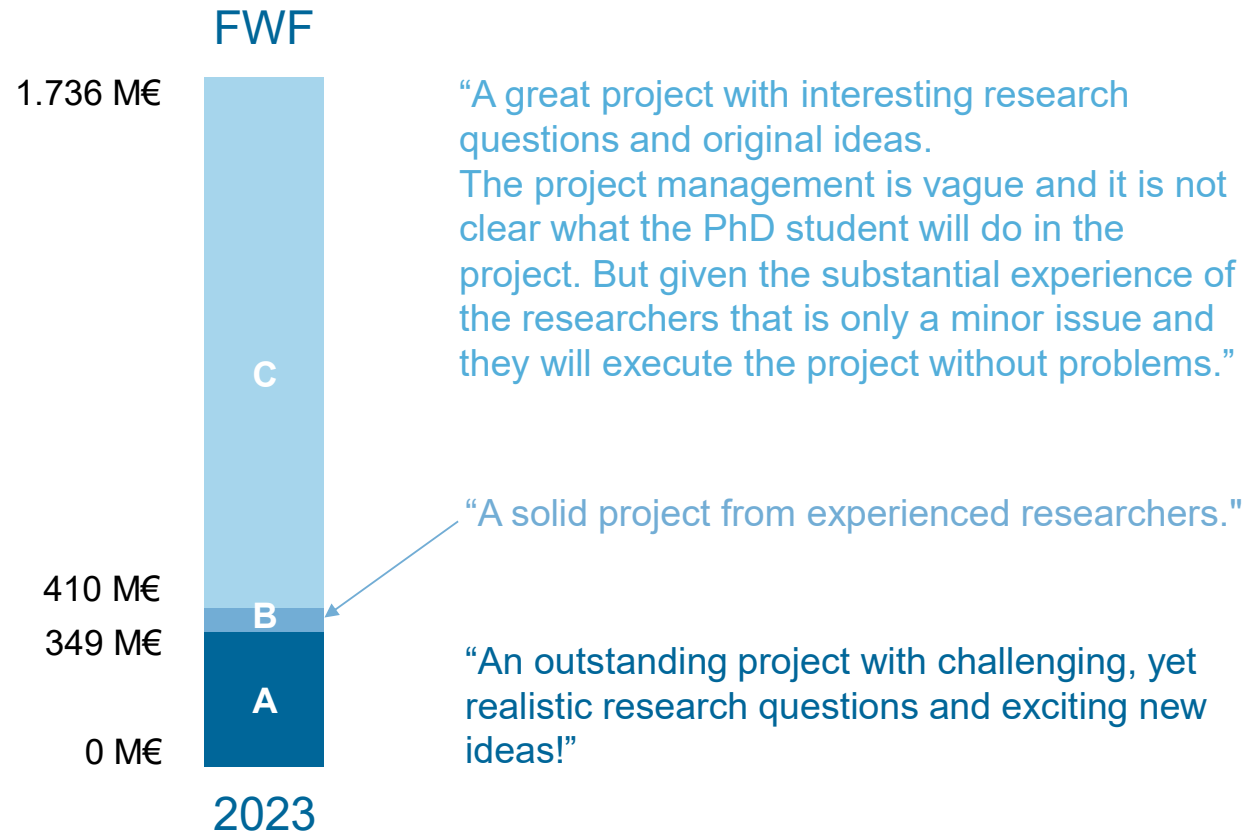

B ... Approved but not funded

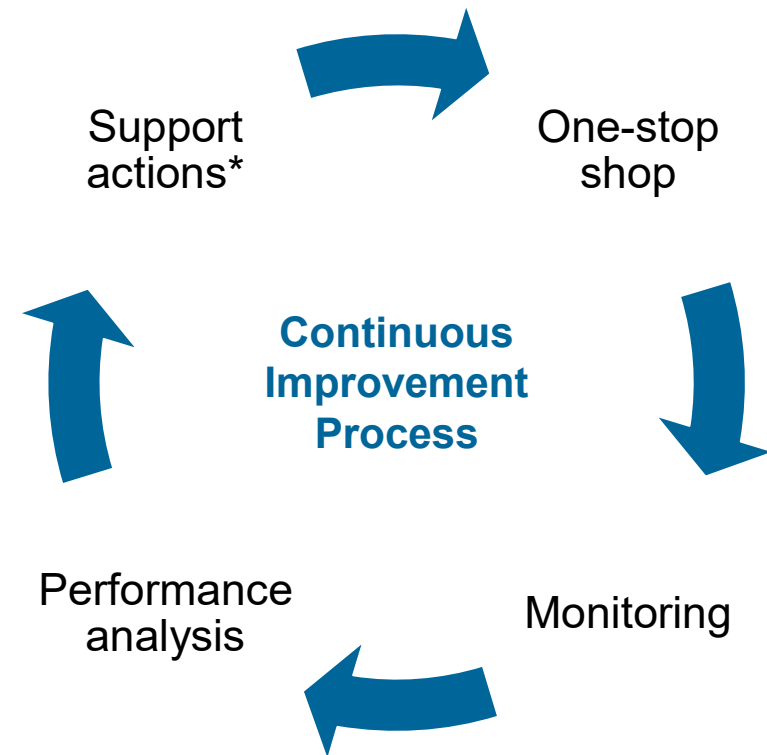

- Rejection reasons



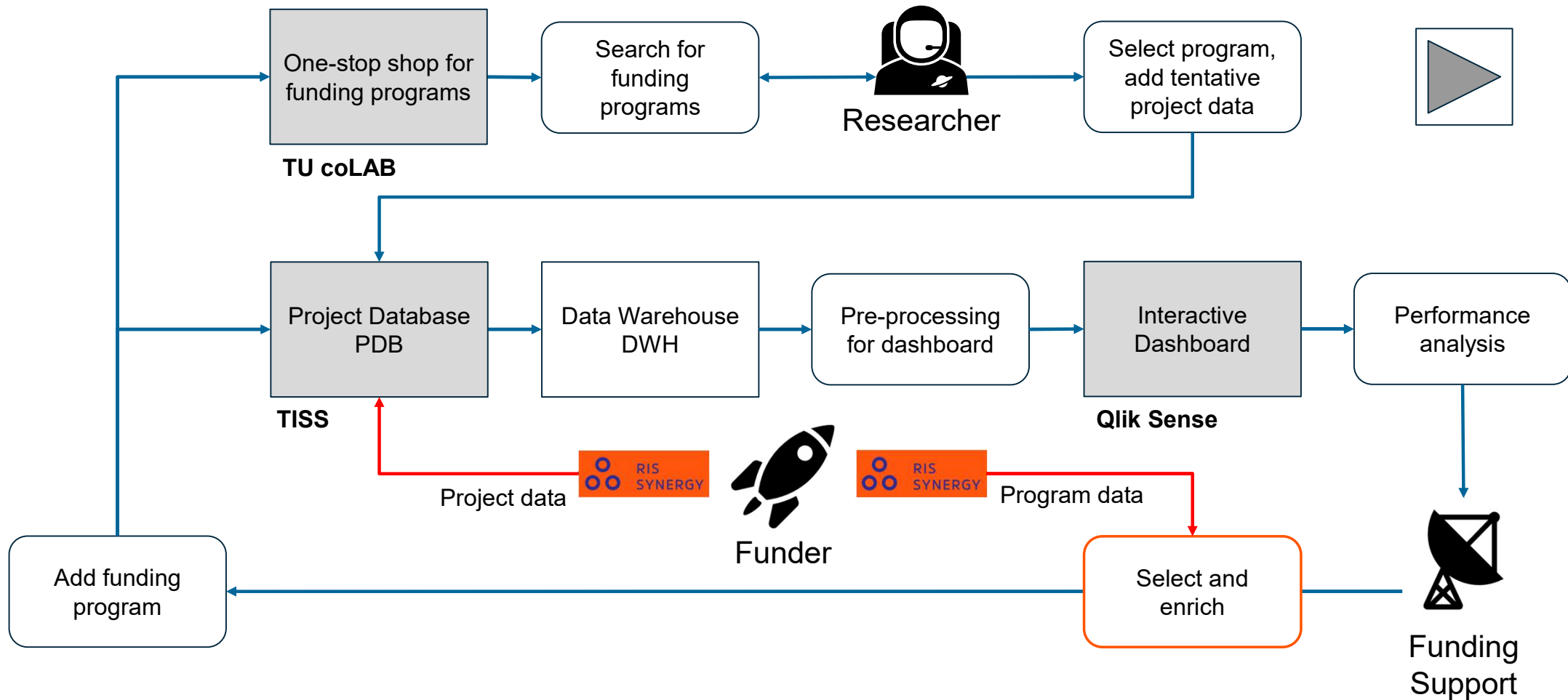

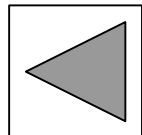

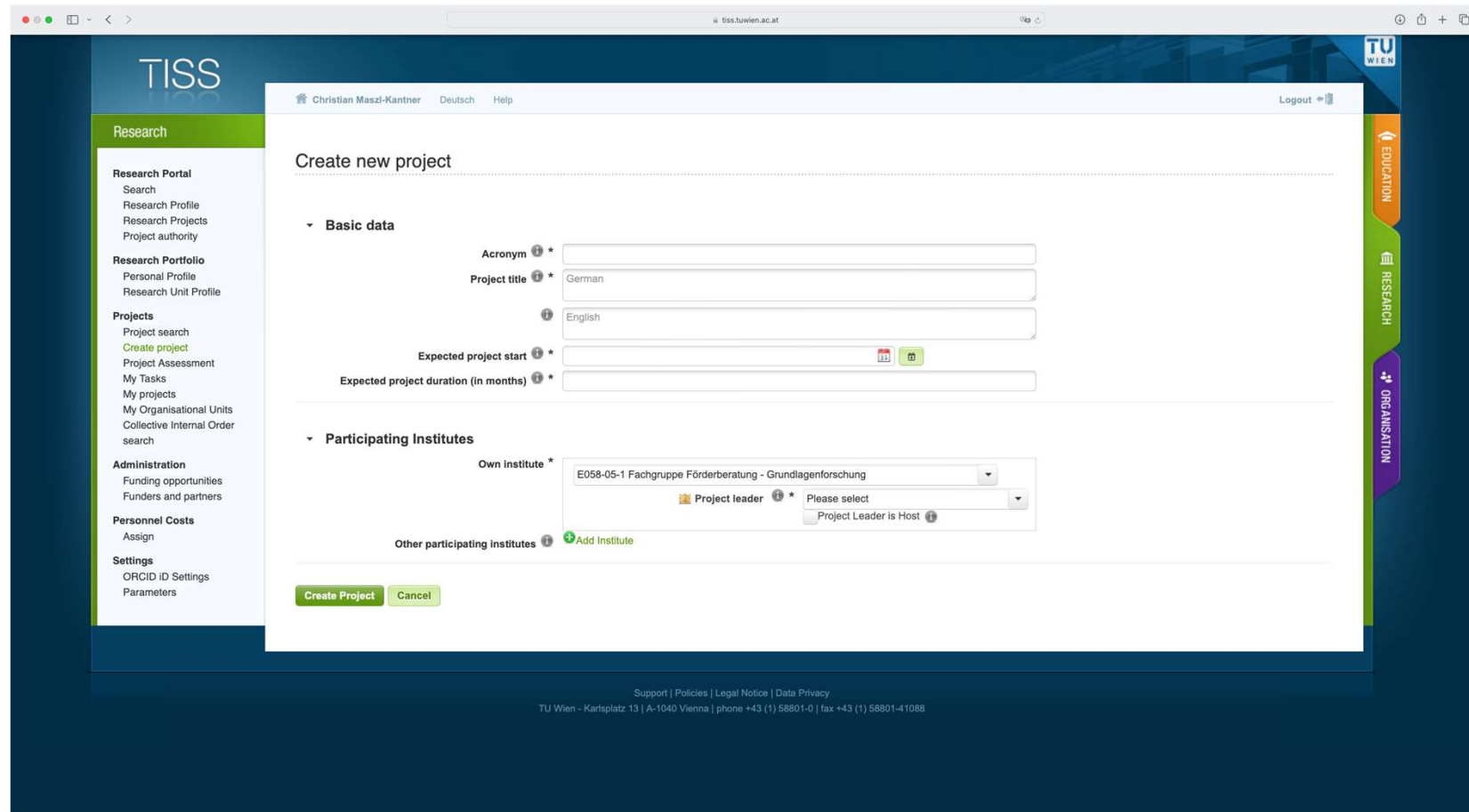
